




- Majority of participants from the south of England










## SUPPLIERS OF NHS BRACES




### SUPPLIERS OF PRIVATELY FUNDED **BRACES**



### TIME SPENT WEARING BRACE


## Spinal Bracing in the NHS


- Large variety in manufacturers of spinal braces and in advice for duration of wear
